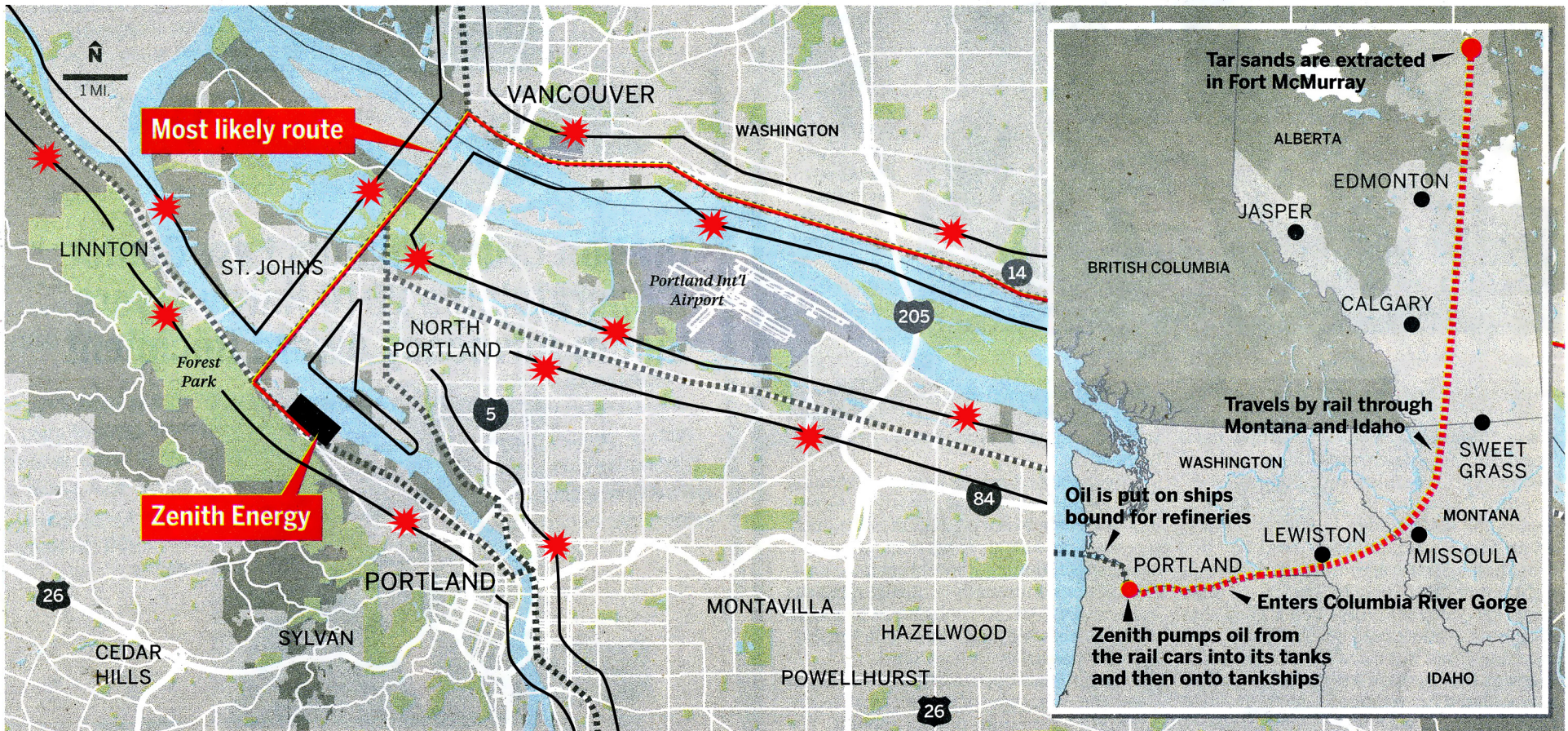


# Route of crude oil trains

There are several routes by which oil trains travel through Portland, pictured below. The most likely way they arrive at Zenith Energy is via Washington and through St. Johns.

Black line is a proximation of initial blast zone in case of an accident or derailment. Additional toxic effects can be expected depending upon the weather, the train's location and its contents.
